


A Trauma-Informed Guidebook for the Foster and Adoptive Journey


Living That Matters

A life of faith centered on the Bible



To be published in 2025, the *Anabaptist Community Bible* will draw readers deeper into faith and provide opportunities for reflecting on the Bible alongside other Anabaptists.

A resource section includes ideas for how to experience peace with God, self, others, and creation, as well as maps, background information on the Bible, interactive ways to pray, and prayers for many occasions.
